

	*Exchange Fee: a \$100 USD fee for In-class exchanges or \$25 USD fee for virtual exchanges has to be covered by each visiting student the first week of classes to finish the registration process and to be active in the University Systems. All students are expected to cover this fee.

Language(s) of Instruction	Spanish/English
Language Requirements	 Language proficiency certificate for Spanish → minimum B2 level. All students must apply a free Spanish test at their arrival to the university and must take a free Spanish course during their semester according to the test results. The course gives 6 credits with 45 classroom hours and 45 study hours per semester. The English certificate it's required when the student wants to take courses taught in English.
Your students are allowed to apply for	 One semester. Full academic year. Trimester or two trimesters (only for graduate degree) Summer. Research stays. Internship (with previous authorization from the receiving School) Medical Rotations (only for partners with specific medical rotation agreements).
Available places	For Academic Exchange Agreements: Each period (semester, summer) 2 places for south campus. 1 places for north campus. If our agreement has a specific number of places, we will give the places according to the agreement. NOTE: If you have more candidates, please send the nominations, and we can receive the extra students according to the availability of spaces in each campus, we'll let you know how many extra students we can receive.
